## SHEEPSKIN CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- Regular Dusting/Brushing: Gently rush the sheepskin to remove dust and loose dirt.
  Use a soft <u>brush</u> or a vacuum cleaner with a brush attachment to keep the fibres looking fresh
- **Spot Cleaning:** If the sheepskin gets stained, blot the area immediately with a clean, damp cloth. Avoid rubbing, as this can damage the wool fibres.
- **Use Mild Detergent:** For deeper cleaning, use a mild, wool-safe detergent diluted in water. Test the solution on a small, inconspicuous area first. Gently hand wash or spot clean the sheepskin, then rinse with clean water.
- Avoid Excess Moisture: Do not soak the sheepskin or expose it to excessive water. Excess moisture can cause the wool to mat or damage the leather backing.
- Air Dry: Allow the sheepskin to air dry naturally, away from direct sunlight or heat sources. Do not tumble dry or use a hairdryer.
- **Brushing After Cleaning:** Once dry, brush the wool with a soft-bristled brush to restore its fluffiness and softness.
